PEDIATRIC FIRST AID | CPR AED

The HSI *Pediatric First Aid | CPR AED* course is designed for individuals who are not healthcare providers or professional rescuers but are required by federal and state regulations to be trained in pediatric first aid and pediatric CPR.

- ✓ Pediatric First Aid | CPR AED has been approved by the HSI Medical Advisory Board and reviewed by the HSI Advisory Council.
- ✓ Reflects the latest resuscitation science and treatment recommendations published by the International Liaison Committee on Resuscitation (ILCOR).

Intended audience

Individuals who are primarily responsible for children, such as school personnel (teachers, bus drivers, coaches), seasonal leaders (camp counselors, lifeguards, youth group leaders), and licensed childcare providers.

Certification period

- 2 years from month of issue

Student certification requirements

- Performance evaluation: All students must perform required skills competently without assistance.
- Written evaluation: Required when specified by organizational, local, or state regulation. It is recommended for designated responders with a duty or employer expectation to respond in an emergency and provide first aid care.

Recommended time to complete

- Pediatric First Aid | Child, Infant, and Adult CPR AED: 2 ¾ - 8 ¼ hours
- Pediatric First Aid | Child and Infant CPR AED: 2 ¼ - 7 hours
- Pediatric First Aid: 1 - 5 hours
- CPR AED Child, Infant, and Adult: 2 ½ - 5 hours
- CPR AED Child and Infant: 1 ¾ - 3 ¾ hours
