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How do I search for specific content in the HSI Blue Ocean Brain Library?

Note: Some organizations have access to a limited HSI Blue Ocean Brain Library; the following applies to organizations accessing the full HSI Blue Ocean Brain Library.

The HSI Blue Ocean Brain (BOB) Library contains thousands of Lessons on a variety of professional development topics. There are two ways to search the Library: Learning Topic Search and Keyword Search.

Learning Topic Search

On the left side of the Library landing page, you'll find different Learning Topics under "Discover Learning Topics" heading. To explore lessons and articles within a topic, select your desired topic. Beneath the Learning Topic is a short description of the type of content learners can explore, including subcategories to further refine your search. Selecting a subtopic displays Lessons that address that particular topic; selecting a Lesson opens the first Article of that Lesson. To view all subtopics within each Learning Topic, select Browse All under Discover Learning Topics on the left side.

Keyword Search

To search for additional lessons or articles using a specific keyword or words, enter the desired search terms into the box labeled "Search for skills and topics" at the top center of the page. A dropdown menu containing 5 suggestions based on the search terms will appear. Either select one of the suggestions, or press enter to view all search results. Select Load More Results at the bottom of the page to expand the list of results. To change how your search results are sorted, select the dropdown menu under Sort Order and select either "Relevance" or "Newest".

To change the type of search results that are displayed, select Filter. From here, you can filter your search results by:

- **Content Type:** Select "All Content" to see both lessons and articles, "Lessons" to see only full lessons, "Articles" to see only individual articles, or "Video-Centric" to see video only content.
- **Completion Status:** Select "All" to see all content, "In Progress" to see content you've begun but haven't completed, "Completed" to see content you've completed, and "Not Started" to see content you have not yet interacted with!
- **Video Included:** Select "All" to see all content, "Has Video" to see content with video resources embedded, and "Has No Video" to see content that does not include video resources.
- **Lesson Brief Included:** Select this checkbox to see lessons and articles that have an accompanying Lesson Brief.
- **Currently Bookmarked:** Select this checkbox to return to content you have bookmarked in HSI Blue Ocean Brain.

Once you have selected your desired filters on your search results, select **Apply** to refine your search results. Select Clear to remove any filters from your search results.

What do the "Recently Featured," "Recommended for You," and "Trending Lessons" sections mean in the Library?

The HSI Blue Ocean Brain Library highlights lessons in three different sections: Recently Featured, Recommended for You, and Trending Lessons.

The "Trending Lessons" section is located in the upper left-hand corner of the HSI Blue Ocean Brain Library's landing page. The trending lessons are the Lessons that all HSI Blue Ocean Brain Learners are viewing most often within the past 60 days.

The "Recently Featured" section, which can be found on the HSI Blue Ocean Brain Library's landing page, allows learners to keep track of featured lessons they may have missed or not completed. Featured lessons are listed in chronological order, from newest to oldest.

The "Recommended for You" section features lessons learners can complete at least 30 days old.

How do I know when I've completed a HSI Blue Ocean Brain lesson?

Note: To complete a Lesson, all three assets within the Lesson must be individually completed.

If you're on the HSI Blue Ocean Brain website or using the mobile app and want to complete the Featured Lesson on the BOB dashboard, select the first Article to the right hand side of your dashboard.

Once you've finished reading and/or completing any Show-What-You-Know questions found within the asset, the asset that you've completed will show a green circle with a white check mark. An asset that is incomplete will show a partially filled circle, indicating that you may need to revisit the asset and complete any remaining questions to complete the asset.

When looking at a Lesson in the Library, you'll notice that each Lesson has a circle in the top left corner. The circles that are fully green with a white check mark inside signify Lessons that have already been completed. If the Lesson has not been accessed, the circle will be fully white, and if the Lesson has been partially completed, the circle will be partially green.

Note: To see a full record of all past Lessons completed, navigate to HSI Blue Ocean Brain. Then, select Profile, then "My Learning" from the dropdown menu. Once the My Learning page has loaded, select the Learning tab, then filter on "Completed".
