What Is IACET and Why Do Organizations Add CEUs?

IACET is an internationally recognized standard-setting organization for continuing education and training. Organizations benefit from offering HSI's IACET CEUs in many ways, including:

- providing assurance that the content is evaluated to be effective, accurate, and well-supported; it's "the best in class"
- enabling CEUs without new content or implementation projects
- supporting employee development initiatives

- enhancing the value of all safety training courses regardless of CEUs offered



HSI IACET Details

Eligible learners earn 0.1 IACET CEU for each qualifying course completed, when they:

- achieve a passing score of 80% or higher,
- confirm their identity through the honor code, and
- complete required course evaluations.
