## **Customer Overview:**

VTac is an approved HSI Training Center in northwest New Mexico. Co-owners Paul and Candice Mitchell are retired public safety training professionals with a long history of serving their community. Paul is a retired Training Chief for a municipal fire department, and Candice recently retired from her position of Director of a state-accredited police academy.

Leaning on their years of service and training expertise, they started VTac as a way to continue their passion for training and share real-world experiences with organizations and individuals in their community.

## **Challenge:**

Co-owners Paul and Candice Mitchell operate a busy Training Center where they also have roles as lead instructors. One of VTac's primary audiences is teachers and school personnel. Through HSI's AVERT program, they're able to empower teachers by giving them reallife scenarios and hands-on practice that helps to diminish fear and build confidence.

We conducted the main class and then we went to each individual branch to do scenario drills. We felt it was important for them to be able to train in their own environment and see things like... What's their plan when they're at their workstation? What's their plan if somebody walks in? Where are they going to go? What are they going to do? We conduct drills in their own environment to show them a plan. Then, they can build on that plan with additional ideas."

### Building a Training Center Business using HSI Emergency Care Programs:
