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Getting the most out of your NERC Certification: Exam Preparation Program

Following these steps will help your students maximize the NERC Certification: Exam Preparation Program:

- 1. Pre-Assessment Evaluation taking this test highlights areas of strengths and weaknesses to better plan your student's specific training needs. You can then place them in the program at the point best suited to their experience and background
- 2. Online Training Courses complete all recommended training, including NERC Certification: Exam Preparation program and additional training identified through the Pre-Assessment Evaluation. Take advantage of instructor coaching calls as needed
- 3. NERC Standards study and reference the NERC Standards associated with each lesson
- **4.** End-of-lesson test complete each end-of-lesson test. If your student doesn't answer all questions correctly, they should restudy the areas that need improvement. Students should not take the end-of-lesson test without completing the material
- 5. End-of-course test similar to the end-of lesson test, students should take this test after completing all of the lessons in a course. If all questions are not answered correctly, the areas needing improvement should be re-studied
- 6. Ohm Exam after all courses and tests are completed, students should take the Ohm Exam to measure their knowledge level and determine if they are ready for the NERC exam. Students should not re-take the Ohm exam until they have thoroughly reviewed the material.
- 7. NERC Certification: Exam Preparation Instructor-Led class take the class as a final material review. Students should not take it before completing the online training as it is designed to complement the online program.
