I got into this field totally by accident. I started off getting an Environmental Biology degree, then went to work for a power plant in North Dakota doing title five and emissions type control. I found out I really liked the power industry.

What do you like best about your job?

What project are you most proud of?

About 2011, the Saudis decided to nationalize their workforce after relying on expatriate labor for years. They set aside monies for companies to hire apprentices. They placed them in different colleges, around the country. We helped set up three apprenticeship programs. They are still running today.

It's a great feeling to see people who don't do well in school succeed. They're technical learners, not academic. They're more hands on. They understand concepts, not theory. So, once we

got them into new trades they weren't exposed to throughout their lives, they really excel in those fields. Not only does it help the lives of those individuals, but it also helps the company. Because now they have a skilled labor pool. They don't have to try to find employees from outside their own country. It's a successful program and will continue for years to come.

It's about human performance and operational safety. When you think about health and safety, most people think about OSHA, arc flash, and NACP standards.
